Principal's Note:

Olympics Day: Next Wednesday 30th May some 200 students from the Monaro rural schools will be visiting Dalgety PS for an Olympics Day. The Dalgety P & C are offering a meal deal (see attached). If you would like your child to have a meal deal please return the form to school with the money by Thursday. Students will rotate around a sequence of active activities (mostly outside) and therefore need to wear runners, long pants and warm jumpers.

Premiers Sporting Challenge: This year we have enrolled in the Premier's Sporting Challenge. To be successful students need to complete at least 20 minutes of physical activity each day for 10 school weeks. We have chosen 5 weeks of this term starting this week and the first 5 weeks of Term 3. Each child has their individual log to record their activity. We will be trying to spend 20 minutes each school day in physical activity, though students may also record physical activity out of school hours in 20 minute slots. Activities such as playing footy, trampolining, horse riding, chasing the sheep would all count. Getting fit will mean skiing will be easier, especially cross country skiing. It's a great opportunity for you to join in and get fit too.

<u>Dalgety Women's Day:</u> The students sang beautifully at last week's Dalgety Women's Day. A huge thank you to Margo McCabe and her friends Elizabeth MacKinnon and Mary Lette who made it all happen. The students made thoughtful thankyou cards for Margo, Elizabeth and Mary. Because of our very busy schedule this term and next, we are going to have a break from music lessons and restart in Term 4.

Friday's tennis lessons have been going extremely well with students improving every week in their ball skills and tennis skills. Thursday afternoon's boot camp has also been a huge success with student's fitness improving whilst participating in fun activities with Mrs Kym Armstrong. Mrs Bartell is actively participating and thoroughly enjoying the boot camp.

<u>Canberra excursion:</u> Bookings are being made for the Canberra excursion to complement the upper school students' unit of work on government. Please put the following dates in your calendar though details are likely to change. The proposed plan at the moment is: On Wednesday 20th June Year 3 & 5 students would travel to Canberra and visit The National Museum of Australia, Old Parliament House and new Parliament House with an evening ice skating activity followed by staying the night in Canberra. On Thursday 21st June Kinder, Year 1 and 2 students would come to Canberra for the day to meet up with the Year 3/5's and visit Questacon including 2 science shows and visits to the hands-on exhibits. One parent (preferably male) would accompany myself and the Year 3/5's. Anja & Cathy would accompany the Kinder-Year 2 students.

Well done to the Year 3 & 5 students who completed the 4 Australian wide NAPLAN tests last week. Results will be sent out to the school later in the year.

<u>Assembly:</u> Most Monday afternoons at approximately 2.40pm, we are having a student assembly led by one of the Year 5 students. Students sing our national anthem and present work, weekly certificates are presented and treasure box awards are drawn. The Year 5 student will also begin to write a speech on a weekly value. Parents are welcome to attend.

<u>Rewards:</u> We have a reward system operating at school where students get a ticket for following instructions, completing jobs without being asked, being nice to each other, being positive and doing their best work. Winners are drawn at assembly for a gift from the treasure box.

It's great when students arrive at school at about 8.45am, so they have time in a relaxed manner to get their reading & homework books out, do their jobs, go to the toilet, have a chat and play a game all before the bell goes.
